What we are learning!

PK 4: We will read a Halloween book today. The title is <u>Minerva Louise on Halloween</u>. This is a silly story of a hen who finds out things about Halloween and then tries to do them.

Kindergarten: We reviewed <u>The Bad Seed</u> story. We then talked about who was telling the story and how we knew that. I read the story <u>Pumpkin Hill</u> to them.

First Grade: We will continue with alphabetizing. They will find out what to do if the first letter is the same in all the words

Second Grade: They will do a worksheet on the title page and find other things on the this page.

Third Grade: They will finish the scavenger hunt. This time they will look for a certain book and then write the call number on the answer sheet. They will work in teams.

Fourth Grade: They will do the first book report of the year. We will talk about the characteristics of a mystery. They will fill out part of the book report. We will then talk about what they need to look for in the book that they are reading in fill out the rest of the book report.

Fifth/ Sixth Grade: The students will be put in teams to start brain storming their folktale. They work on the plot of the story, the problem.

Seventh/ Eighth: The groups received the 3 sections of the Dewey system to work on. We reviewed what was in each section. Now they need to find 5 pictures that would fit in their sections.

PreK-3: I told a story about a pumpkin as I cut it out.
