What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book Fly Guy Presents Firefighters. We talked a little about fire safety.

PK 3: I read the book Firefighters Help. We talked a little about fire safety.

Kindergarten: I read the book Stop, Drop and Roll. We reviewed the character and setting part of the story. They had a worksheet where they had to put the setting with character.

First Grade: We worked on a nonfiction and a fiction sheet together.

Second Grade: They learned about how to pick a book. Things they need to look for when choosing a book to read. We also reviewed what shelf markers are and how we use them.

Third Grade: They will pick a science fiction book. They will have a book report due after MEA. They worked on finishing up their nonfiction discovery sheet.

Fourth Grade: They were introduced to historical fiction and what makes up historical fiction. They needed to pick a historical fiction book. They will do a book report on it. It will be due after MEA. Some finished up their task cards.

Fifth/ Sixth Grade: We reviewed metaphors, similes and personification. We then talked about onomatopoeia. They were given a personification worksheet.

Seventh/Eighth Grade: They will be playing a Dewey card game.

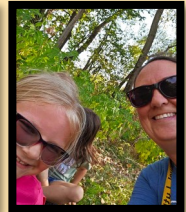
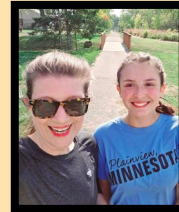
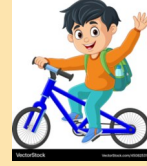
