Notes from Mrs. M & the Library! Building a Reader at Home

Things to do during reading of the book:

- Stop at certain places to talk about what is happening in the story.
- Talk about their misunderstandings.
- Predict what will happen next and ask why.
- Bring concepts they miss to their attention.
- Ask older children about the character traits the main character has both inside and outside.

Preschool: Learn Parts of Book. Learn what illustrator is and does. Book- "Turkey Trouble." Kindergarten: Learn difference between fiction and non-

fiction

1st Grade: Alphabetizing Same Letter Words

2nd Grade: "Paper Bag Princess"– Learn Princess's Character Traits.

3rd Grade: What is the Authors Purpose to Write Books 4th Grade: Looking things up in the Encyclopedia, work on the main idea.

5/6 Grade: Write and edit their Fable

7/8 Grade: They will pick a New Berry Winner to read and write a report.
