What We are Learning!

Preschool 4's: We reviewed the idea that an author can do both the writing and the illustrations. I told them that Leo liked doing things outside and watching animals. He wrote stories about that. I read Little Blue and Little Yellow.

Preschool 3's: I read the story Kindness Grows. We talked about how kindness makes us strong and helps people who feel mad or angry.

Kindergarten: We are learning about the author Eric Carle. He is an author and an illustrator. He liked using tissue and paint to do his illustrations. I read the story The Tiny Seed. We made a page about that book.
