#### What we are learning 1/31/24!

PreK 4: We reviewed asking permission and accepting no. Then I read the story <u>Daniel says I'm Sorry</u>. When we do something that hurts a friend we need to say I'm sorry to them but also tell them why I am sorry. Then what I can do to make it better for my friend.

Kindergarten: We reviewed the story <u>The Three Ninja Pigs</u> and then they wrote on their paper what the opening was, beginning, the middle and the end. I read the story <u>Sneezy the Snowman</u>.

First Grade: They will review the parts to <u>Stand Tall Mary Lou Melon</u>. We then talked about character traits. There are some that are outside, Physical traits and those that are inside a person, those we learn by knowing the person.

Second Grade: They reviewed the story of <u>The Paper Bag Princess</u>. They did a worksheet about Ronald's character traits

Third Grade: They are playing a Bingo game for Genres.

Fourth Grade: They did a worksheet for finding the main idea in the paragraph.

Fifth/Sixth Grade: They worked on a task cards where they decided if it is 1st person, 2nd person, 3 person, plus 3rd person limited or omniscient.

Seventh/ Eighth Grade: They rewatched the PowerPoint on plagiarism again as a review. They asked some good questions after viewing it a second time.
