Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book I is for Turkey. We talked about the Pilgrims celebrated thanksgiving first. We also talked about how the Indians and Pilgrims became friends.

PK 3: I read the book Giving Thanks. We talked a little bit how we need to thank God for all the things He does for us and gives us.

Kindergarten: We talked about books and what they have in them. We reviewed characters and settings. Then we added the problem and the solution ideas to the book. I gave them pictures to sort into conflict (problem) and into resolution (solution). Then we talked about how some problems we can solve and those that we need help with.

First Grade: They continued to work on alphabetizing. We reviewed how the alphabet never changes. They worked on their own worksheet.

Second Grade: They reviewed the alphabetical order and where it is all used. They then did task cards and put the words into alphabetical order.

Third Grade: Some worked on their book reports. We reviewed the reasons why authors write books. Then they had to cut and paste some books or ideas into the areas that we had discussed.

Fourth Grade: They reviewed the things they would find in the encyclopedia. Then they found the volumes they needed for the answers on their worksheet.

Fifth/ Sixth Grade: We looked at the last figure of speech allusion. This means connecting the thought to a event, object, historical person. They did an idiom worksheet.

Seventh/Eighth Grade: They worked at finishing the scavenger hunt.

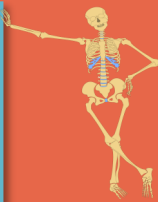
