Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What We are Learning!

Preschool 4's: We read the story Over and Under. We reviewed this book. Then we did a work sheet on coloring the animals that are under the ground and those who are over the ground a different color.

Preschool 3's: I read the book Try a little Kindness. Then we talked about kindness and sorted not kind and kind pictures.

Kindergarten: We reviewed the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff. Then the students drew a picture in each of the three areas of the book.

1st Grade: We reviewed the parts of a book. We reviewed where the table of contents is found, what it tells us. They then completed another worksheet on the table of contents.

2nd Grade: Each of the students worked with a dictionary and found a word. They wrote down their word, what the guide words are, what parts of speech it is, and how many syllables. They then wrote one of the definitions. Then wrote a sentence with their word.

3rd Grade: I introduced what Genre's are. We looked at the labels we use in this library. They can find them on the spines on most of the books.

4th Grade: They reviewed the items that can be used as reference books. They did a work sheet that they had to find the right reference book to match the description.

5/6 Grade: We played another game to help them remember the 10 areas that are in the Dewey decimal system.

7/8 Grade: They just picked out books to read.
