Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

Building a Reader at Home

- ◆ Beginner readers and even older children need to see you reading. This shows them that reading is important. You are modeling reading to them.
- ◆ Younger readers need to read the pictures in books. Encourage them to "read" the pictures, this helps the child understand what is going on.
- ◆ Ask your older child about the book they are reading. What do they like, what they would change, and what the problem or plot is. This helps with comprehension.

Preschool: Learn Parts of Book and Fall Story, they will learn what an author is and does.

Kindergarten: Learn difference between author and illustrator

1st Grade: Alphabetizing in the Library

2nd Grade: Match call numbers to authors last name.

3rd Grade: Finding Call Numbers

4th Grade: Learning to use the Encyclopedia in Teams

5/6 Grade: Start to get ideas together then write a Fable in Teams. The Moral, Setting, Characters, and Plot.

7/8 Grade: They will get books to read
