Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book Winter is Here. This book told us about things that people like to did in winter. The children learned sign language for winter turns to spring. Ask them to show you.

PK 3: I read the book The Mouse that Jack Built. The story told the children the sequence of how he made the mouse snowman. The mice int the story then made some snow bunnies to play with the snow mouse.

Kindergarten: We went back to learn more about the parts of a book. They had a worksheet where they had to trace the word and then write the word. Then they needed to circle where that was found on the book. I read It's Snow and Winter. Ask them what the difference was.

First Grade: They reviewed the parts of a book. We then concentrated on the cover of the book. They needed to find the correct item on the cover and glue on the word.

Second Grade: We finished their escape room together.

Third Grade: They worked on finishing their escape room. They have a few more pieces to put together to find the answer.

Fourth Grade: They reviewed what an encyclopedia had in it for resources. They did a worksheet where they read a piece about Frank Lloyd Wright and then they needed to write it in their own words.

Fifth and 6th Grade: They finished their escape room.

Seventh and 8th Grade: They did a worksheet on fact and opinion.
