Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book P is for Pumpkin. We talked about how God makes many things happen in fall. They all are things in the alphabet.

PK 3: I read the book Giving Thanks. We talked a little bit how we need to thank God for all the things He does for us and gives us.

Kindergarten: We talked about books and what they have in them. We reviewed characters and settings. Then we added the problem and the solution ideas to the book. I read the book Turkey Trouble to them. We discussed the problem and how the problem was solved.

First Grade: They continued to work on alphabetizing. We reviewed how the alphabet never changes. They worked on their own work sheet.

Second Grade: They reviewed the alphabetical order and where it is all used. They then tried to look at the second letter of a word if the words had the same letter.

Third Grade: They worked on their book reports. Then we worked together on a work sheet of author's purpose. We found in the story how they got their idea for the answers.

Fourth Grade: They watched a power point on the encyclopedia. They then looked at the set of encyclopedias we have in the library. They saw how each article is divided up and bold words let them know what each section is about.

Fifth/ Sixth Grade: We looked at the onomatopoeia worksheet and answered their questions. We then did some learning about idioms.

Seventh/Eighth Grade: They did not have a library time as they were doing an election learning project.
