



Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What We are Learning!

Preschool 4's: We read the story Animals in Winter. We then talked about the book and how it gave us information. It helped us to understand how animals go through the winter.

Preschool 3's: I read the book Try a little Kindness. Then I introduced them to Ms. K. She has a kaboom kick that she is proud of but she is even more proud of when she is kind.

Kindergarten: We reviewed the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff. Then the students made a book with pictures of the beginning, middle and end.

1st Grade: We reviewed the parts of a book. We reviewed where the table of contents is found. Today we added the index. They learned that the index is at the back of the book and gives the page number of what they would be looking for.

2nd Grade: We reinforced the guide word concept. We worked on a worksheet together to put the right words on the right page.

3rd Grade: We worked on a work sheet page together. The worksheet is called Genre Joe's Pizza. Next week they will work on their own with the 14 descriptions of the genre to label a pizza.

4th Grade: They reviewed the reference material and then played a game where they got a description and had to guess the reference it was talking about.

5/6 Grade: We had teams that worked together to put books in the right section of the Dewey Decimal system.

7/8 Grade: They just picked out books to read.


