What we are learning 3/13/24!

PreK 4: I read the book <u>Pete the Cat and the Missing Cupcakes</u>. I used this to start them what a mystery is. We counted the cupcakes, found the clues, saw that Pete the Cat forgive Grumpy Toad and because of the forgiving Grumpy Toad ,Pete the cat got 16 new cupcakes for his party.

PreK 3: I read <u>Groovy Joe Ice Cream and Dinosaurs</u>. Groovy Joe loves his doggy Ice cream and by the end of the book he is sharing it with the dinosaurs.

Kindergarten: We reviewed the <u>Ninja Red Riding</u> ninja moves. We then talked about the hero of the story <u>Ninja Red Riding Hood</u>. We thought of words that would describe the hero. Then we talked about this part in the story. Then I read <u>Moo with Who</u> to them.

First Grade: We are beginning the parts of a book. We watched a video that told us about the parts of a book.

Second Grade: They are learning about Genres. We are starting with Fairy Tales. They learned the characteristics of a fairy tale. I read a fairy tale to them. They picked one book from the pile of fairy tales for one of their books. We will start on their first book report next week.

Third Grade: They picked out a science fiction book to read. Then they worked on another worksheet to match genres.

Fourth Grade: They finished their book report on science fiction. Some still need to finish their book.

Fifth/Sixth Grade: We went through the point of view sheet together and did some discussion.

Seventh/ Eighth Grade: They handed in their work sheet. Then we went through the next one main idea, paraphrasing, and summary sheet together so they could work on the next part by themselves.
