Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning 1/24/24!

PreK 4: I read the story <u>We ask permission</u>. We reviewed idea of saying no. We talked about how if we want something another person has we should ask before taking it. I said, "This is good manners. Our Friends like when we use good manners."

Kindergarten: We will review the concept of beginning, middle and end. I used the concept of how ninja's do certain things when doing ninja positions. I read the story Three Ninja Pigs to them. Then we talked about the parts of the story.

First Grade: They will review the parts to a story. I read the story Stand Tall MaryLou Melon. We did a sheet that they named the 4 characters in the story.

Second Grade: They reviewed the story of The Paper Bag Princess. They did a worksheet about Elizabeth's character traits.

Third Grade: They finished the guessing what the Genre of a book would be from a description that was presented.

Fourth Grade: We talked about how they can figure out the main idea. We read a story about ice cream. They needed to answer the questions that were asked, such as what was the main idea, where they could find certain ice creams and an inference question.

Fifth/Sixth Grade: They worked on a worksheet where they had to write down the view point and justify their answer.

Seventh/ Eighth Grade: They watch a PowerPoint about plagiarism. They also took notes on the presentation.
