What we are learning 4/10/24!

PreK 4: I read the story I read the story, <u>Too Many Carrots.</u> In this story the Rabbit always found new carrots to put in his pile. One day his house was too full of carrots for him to sleep. So he tried to solve his problem by going to his friends.....did it work? Ask tour child.

PreK 3: I read <u>Happy Easter, Little Critter</u>. Little Critter told us what happened on Easter Sunday at his house. Ask your child who is friend is.

Kindergarten: I read the story <u>The Turnip</u> by Jan Brett. It is about how the animals tried to get the turnip out of the ground but it didn't come. All of a sudden it came out. Ask your child how it got out. We worked on the parts of the story.

First Grade: We reviewed the spine and what is on it. I found a worksheet for them that they had to find the right last three letters in the author's last name for the spine.

Second Grade: We did another research paper about bats. They had to read the information and then answer the question in complete sentences.

Third Grade: They worked on finding words that came between the guide words. It was harder than they thought..

Fourth Grade: They answered questions about the map of Africa that they had. They need to tell if it was in the North, South, East, or West of the country.

Fifth/Sixth Grade: We reviewed the 10 sections and some of the sub sections in the Dewey order. Then they had a work sheet about the sections.

Seventh/ Eighth Grade: They had to write a paragraph about an article of Cats vs. Dogs using citations.
