What we are learning!

PreK 4: They had the story T is for Turkey. This is an alphabet book about the true Thanksgiving.

First Grade: They will write a story for the illustrations that are given to them.

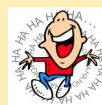
Second Grade: They will review the index, glossary, and table of contents. We will work through the work sheet Apple Orchard together.
