Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!
What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the story Leaf Thief. The main character was a squirrel who thought someone was stealing the leaves from his tree. The bird helped him learn that it was not a thief but the wind.

Kindergarten: I read the story What do Snowman do on Halloween? Then we told a story together The Pumpkin Man. I read the story, they made the sounds and then I drew the pictures.

First Grade: We looked where the author's name is on the book they wrote. They did a worksheet that had them circle the author's name. Then they needed to look at a book and write the title and the author's name.

Second Grade: They learned about the table of contents. Where is found and what it tells us. They did a worksheet on the table of contents.

Third Grade: They will finish the scavenger hunt.

Fourth Grade: They will do the first book report of the year. We will talk about the characteristics of a mystery. They will fill out part of the book report. We will then talk about what they need to look for in the book that they are reading in fill out the rest of the book report.

Fifth/ Sixth Grade: The students will be put in teams to start brain storming their folktale. They will work on the solution to the story.

Seventh/ Eighth: The groups received the 3 sections of the Dewey system to work on. They worked on finding the 5 pictures for their section.

PreK-3: I read a story This is the Turkey.
