Book Nook

Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the Love, Monster. The monster in the book was looking for someone who looked like him to love him. Ask your child who he found.

PK 3: I read the book Valentine's Day. This book talked about things we see and do on Valentine's day.

Kindergarten: We reviewed how fiction and nonfiction are different. They did a work sheet by themselves that had different covers and they needed to put them in the right spot.

First Grade: They learned about the index today. It is also in the back of the book and it is in alphabetical order. The index tells us what pages we can find a subject. They worked on a worksheet.

Second Grade: We reviewed what a main point of a story is. It is why the author wrote the book or article. It is only in a nonfiction book. They were given a sheet of words that they needed to put into three groups. Then what they all think would these words would support the main idea.

Third Grade: They learned what historical fiction was all about. The author takes the event and the setting and tells a fiction story about it. They picked out a historical book and will be doing a book report on it. It will be due Feb.25.

Fourth Grade: They finished their state project.

Fifth and 6th Grade: They are learning about the Dewey Decimal System for the library. We only use it with non-fiction books. Dewey did however, think that fiction should be put in the system as well. The librarians didn't like that idea.

Seventh and 8th Grade: They reviewed the questions that they should ask for figuring out to find out if the author was using facts, bias, opinion or fake news. They then were given 4 articles on the same subject and they had to decide which of the four the article was.

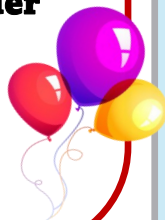
