Notes from Mrs. M & the Library!

What we are learning!

PK 4: I read the book The Pumpkin Patch Parable. We talked about Jesus cleans up our sins and when He does that we have joy and light to shine for Him.

PK 3: I read the book We're going on a Leaf Hunt. We talked a little bit about how each leaf is made different by God just as He makes us different too.

Kindergarten: I reviewed the book The Good, the bad and the Spooky. We talked about the sequence of the story. They then put the pictures in the right sequence.

First Grade: They continued to work on alphabetizing. We reviewed how the alphabet never changes. They worked together in teams to put words in alphabetical order.

Second Grade: They started an escape room together. This escape room goes with picking just the right book. They listened to the story and then we worked together to fill in the blank. The third challenge was done today. They put it on their answer sheet.

Third Grade: They will work on their book report and some of them worked on finishing up their nonfiction discovery sheet. We also talked about how authors have a reason or a purpose for writing their books.

Fourth Grade: They worked on their book report and some of them worked on finishing up their task cards. We also started to learn what reference books are and what they are used for.

Fifth/ Sixth Grade: We corrected the personification paper that they did last week so they could see and hear the mistakes they made.

Seventh/Eighth Grade: They did a scavenger hunt for 24 things in the library.

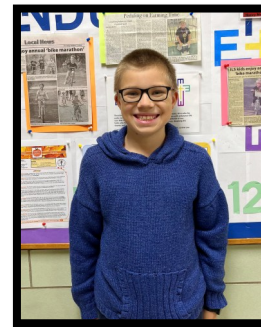
