\* Just a reminder, school is almost done.

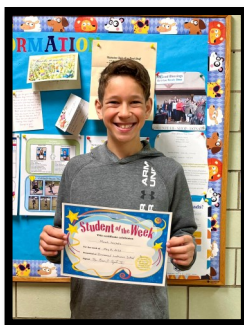
