#### What we are learning 2/19/24!

**PreK 4:** I read the book <u>Loads of Love</u>. The theme of this book is that showing love isn't just for Valentines Day. When ever we are kind and helpful we are showing love.

**Kindergarten:** I read the story <u>Ninja Red Riding Hood.</u> We practiced our ninja moves. Then we talked about the opening, beginning, middle and end of the story. I read them a valentine day story <u>Roses are Pink, Your Feet Really Stink.</u>

**First Grade**: They will review character traits that are on the outside and those on the inside. They then looked for the character traits for Mary Lou.

**Second Grade:** They reviewed the character traits and then found the character traits for the Dragon.

**Third Grade:** They will do a worksheet for genres. Then we will talk about the next book report they will do. This book report will be science fiction.

**Fourth Grade:** They learned about their next book report which will be a realistic fiction book. They then did the mystery bags do find the main idea. This is a worksheet for main ideas.

Fifth/Sixth Grade: They did a worksheet on Point of view. It is called the Titanic. They needed to answer the author's viewpoint, how the text would be different if told from a survivor's point of view.

Seventh/ Eighth Grade: They looked a 12 situations and needed to decide if it was plagiarism or proper use. Then we talked about the difference of Summary and Paraphrasing. We defined what a summary is, what to look for and how to write it.
