Mask Update: Face coverings (masks) will now be optional for students and staff while on site at Immanuel.

Effective dates: Thursday, 2/10/2022—Tuesday, 3/1/2022. The Board of Christian Education will review this change again at their next meeting on Tuesday, March 1, 2022. Current CDC guidelines with regard to quarantines will be followed if a student becomes a close contact of a fellow schoolmate who tests positive for Covid-19.

- If Unmasked while at School: (5 day quarantine at home, Negative Covid-19 Test on Day #5, Return to school on Day #6, Wear a Mask on Days #6-10)
- If Masked while at School: (No immediate quarantine, child may remain in school, monitor child for symptoms of Covid-19 for 10 days)

(Also, no immediate quarantine will be required for a child who is fully vaccinated and no immediate quarantine will be required for a child who has tested positive for Covid-19 themselves in the previous 90 day period.)

\*Final Note: Students who ride the school bus must still wear a mask while riding on the school bus per federal mandate currently in place at least through March 18, 2022.\*
