<u>Mask Update</u> At the January 3rd Board of Christian Education meeting it was decided to keep Immanuel Lutheran School's current adaptation of school policy on masking in place. This policy will then be reviewed again at the next Board meeting on Monday, February 7, 2022. This adaptation is as follows:

All students and staff of Immanuel Lutheran School will be required to wear a face covering (mask) while indoors on site at Immanuel Lutheran School and Church.

(This will include extracurricular school activities while the students and staff are NOT in direct participation—i.e. playing basketball, eating, singing.)

Effective dates: Tuesday, 1/4/2022—Monday, 2/7/2022. The Board of Christian Education will review this adaptation again at their next meeting on Monday, February 7, 2022.

We are nearing 100% in student school attendance, and expect to be there in a few days from now. After nearly two months of quarantines, positive test results, and the many days of many students not being in school, we are excited to have so many students back in the building for in-person learning and would like to not have any setbacks in the upcoming weeks. This policy allows students to remain in school if there is a positive test result in his/her classroom unless that student develops symptoms of Covid-19.


